

WHO DEMANDED FREEDOM ON BUSES?

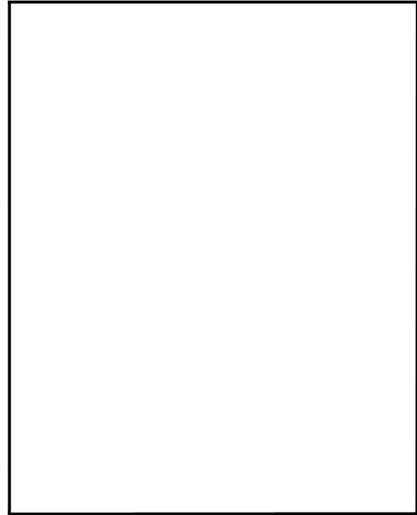
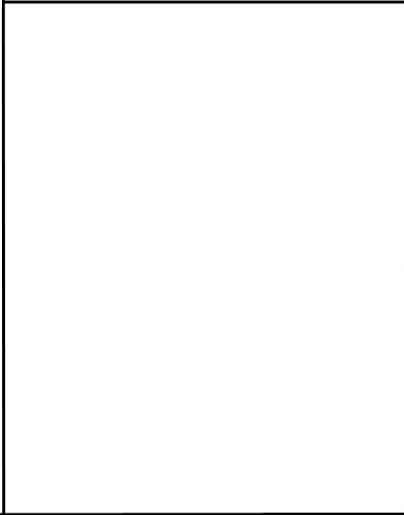

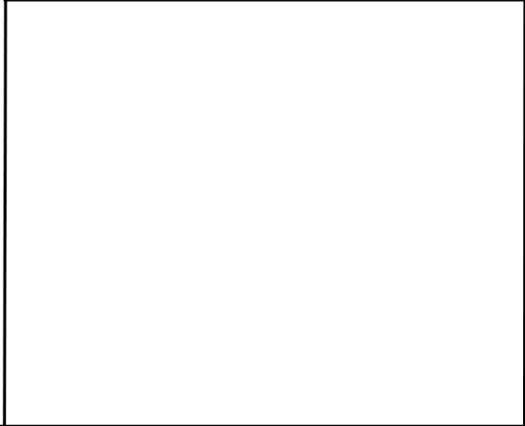
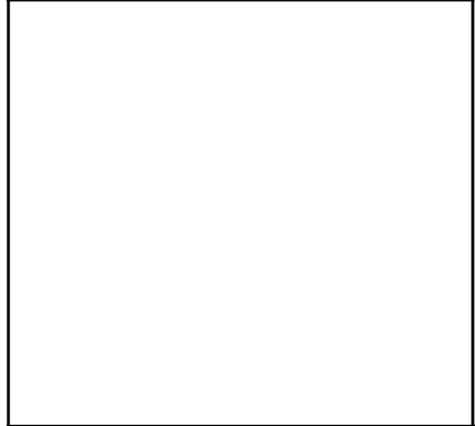
